Objective

The fund seeks long-term growth of capital.

Strategy

The Russell 1000® Index replaces the Russell 1000® Value Index as the fund's broad-based index in compliance with updated regulatory requirements. The Russell 1000® Value Index is a more narrowly based index that reflects the market sector in which the fund invests.

Portfolio management uses a systematic, optimized process to select companies among the large cap universe that offer economic value, as identified by the CROCI® Economic P/E*. CROCI® (Cash Return on Capital Invested) is a proprietary valuation methodology with origins in investment research conducted to identify attractively valued companies across sectors and geographic locations.

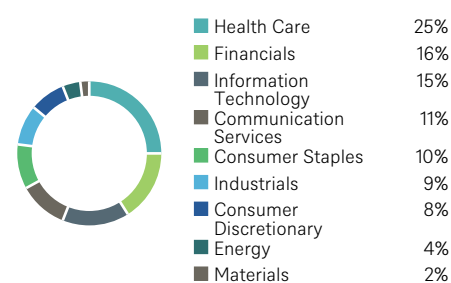
